LISE A TOP LAYER OF FABRIC ON THE PAPER TO PRESS OUT AND FLATTEN THE SHEET.



LASTLY, THE MONKS TAUGHT ME HOW TO MAKE A QUILL USING A FEATHER. THE LARGER FEATHERS WORK BEST.



BY SOAKING THE STEM IN HOT WATER AND USING A PAIR OF TWEEZERS, YOU'LL WANT TO REMOVE THE MEMBRANE FROM THE INSIDE OF THE STEM



CUTTING THE STEM IS MOST TOGETHER WITH QUILL, IMPORTANT FOR CLEAN PAPER, AND INK I'M READY LINES. CHECK OUT MY DRAW

PULP, YOU WILL NEED A MOLD. NOTHING WORKS BETTER THAN A PIECE OF SCREEN FROM A WINDOW AND AN OLD PICTURE FRAME. STAPLE TOGETHER AND VTOLA



USING A SMALL TUB, FILL IT WITH THE BLENDED PULP. STIR IN 2 TEA-SPOONS OF LIQUID STARCH-IT'LL HELP PRE-VENT THE BERRY INK FROM BLEEDING.



SUBMERGE THE MOLD INTO THE PULP. GENTLY WIGGLE IT, UNTIL THE PULP'S THICK ENOUGH AND EVENLY LAYED ON THE SCREEN.



LIFT THE MOLD OUT OF THE WATER TO DRAIN. THIS IS A GOOD TIME TO JUDGE THE THICKNESS OF YOUR PAPER. MORE PULP WILL THICKEN THE PAPER, LESS WILL MAKE IT THINNER.
